

Every Nation Church Seattle Online Community

What is the Online Community?

- It is all about connecting you with others in the church. You can create your own profile, view upcoming events on the calendar, communicate with other people through the online directory or groups, and much more.

To Get Started

- To Log-In go to www.everynationseattle.org , and click “**Login**”. If you have not yet received your log-in and password by email, click “**Sign Up**”. Everyone who requests a log-in must be approved by the church staff to receive a log-in and password.
- **Update Your Profile** (click on the “**My Profile**” link in the upper left hand corner)
- Update your contact information.
- Upload a picture of yourself, and families also upload a family picture on the “Family Profile”
- Fill in some of the “fun” information about yourself.

How do I use the Online Community?

- Best way to see what it is all about, is to log-in and “look around”
- If you decide you don’t want to be a part of the community, you can at anytime request to be “unlisted” or merely discontinue using it.

Is my information private?

- The online community is private, only those who have logins and passwords assigned to them can join in. Everyone who requests a log-in must be approved by the church staff to receive a log-in and password.
- After you log-in, you can decide whether you want to participate, and whether your info will be “listed” to other people in the church who are on the online community. Unlisted info is only seen by staff and key leaders with “administrative privileges”, who contact individuals requesting info or use it as a mailing list.

What are the guidelines for use?

By becoming an Online Community Member you agree to the following rules of use:

- The Online Community is intended for personal use and ministry use. It is not for solicitation of any kind. Do not use it for business purposes or for ministry, groups, etc. outside of the Every Nation Church Seattle community.
- Protect the privacy of members by not giving their contact information, phone number etc., to others outside of the Online Community. If you would like someone’s phone number and they are “unlisted”, please ask them directly. Every Nation Church Seattle cannot give out this information without prior consent.
- Members who engage in discussions are not to “slam” other groups, churches or organizations or attempt to solicit members for outside groups or organizations. Keep the Online Discussion and emails personal, positive, and comfortable. Discussions will be monitored.
- Online members who become inactive at Every Nation Church Seattle or who do not follow these guidelines and/or abuse the Online Community, will have their login access blocked.
